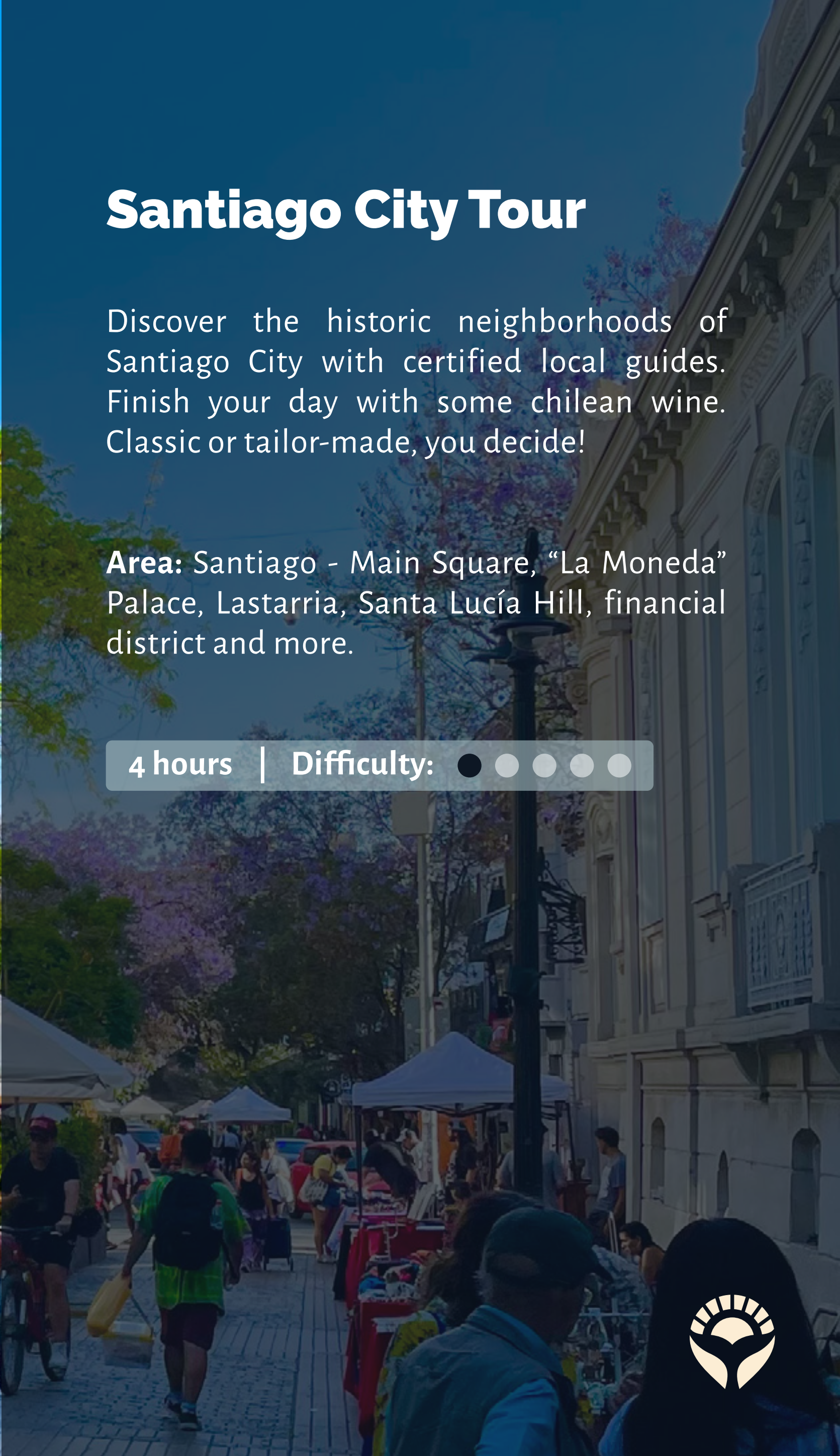


Santiago City Tour
